- Fares are charged based on zones as listed below:

- Exact fare is required. No change will be given if you overpay.
- One-way fares and ten-trip tickets may be purchased on the bus. Contact the MTA to purchase monthly passes.
- MTA Commuter Choice Maryland Vouchers and WMATA Metrocheks (that have not been previously used) are accepted.
- Reduced fares are available for senior citizens and people with disabilities. To be eligible, you must present a valid MTA photo ID, WMATA photo ID, or a Medicare card upon boarding the bus.
- Transit Link Cards allow for unlimited use of MTA Commuter Bus (up to the indicated zone), Metrorail, Metrobus, and Ride-On during the indicated month.
- Passengers may ride free of charge from Harry S. Truman to all other Annapolis stops on all eastbound 921, 922 and 950 trips.

Snow Emergency Plan

In the event that adverse weather conditions necessitate a change or deviation in the morning schedule, announcements will be made on radio stations WBAL (1090 AM Baltimore), WMAL (630 AM Washington), WYRE (1080 AM), WNAV (1430 AM), WANN (1190 AM), WRSI (107.9 FM), and WHFS (99.1 FM). If the morning service does not operate, then the afternoon service will not operate.

When the U.S. Office of Personnel Management authorizes the early release of federal workers due to inclement weather, buses will still depart according to the regular schedule. Riders at intermediate stops should expect delays.

Additional Service

Nos. 922 and **950** lines operate directly between Annapolis and Downtown Washington.

A Guaranteed Ride Home program is available for personal emergencies and unscheduled overtime. Participants must be registered with the Annapolis Regional Transportation Management Association (ARTMA) to use this service.

Days of Operation

The No. 921 line operates Monday thru Friday. It does not operate on Saturdays, Sundays, and the following federally-observed holidays:

New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

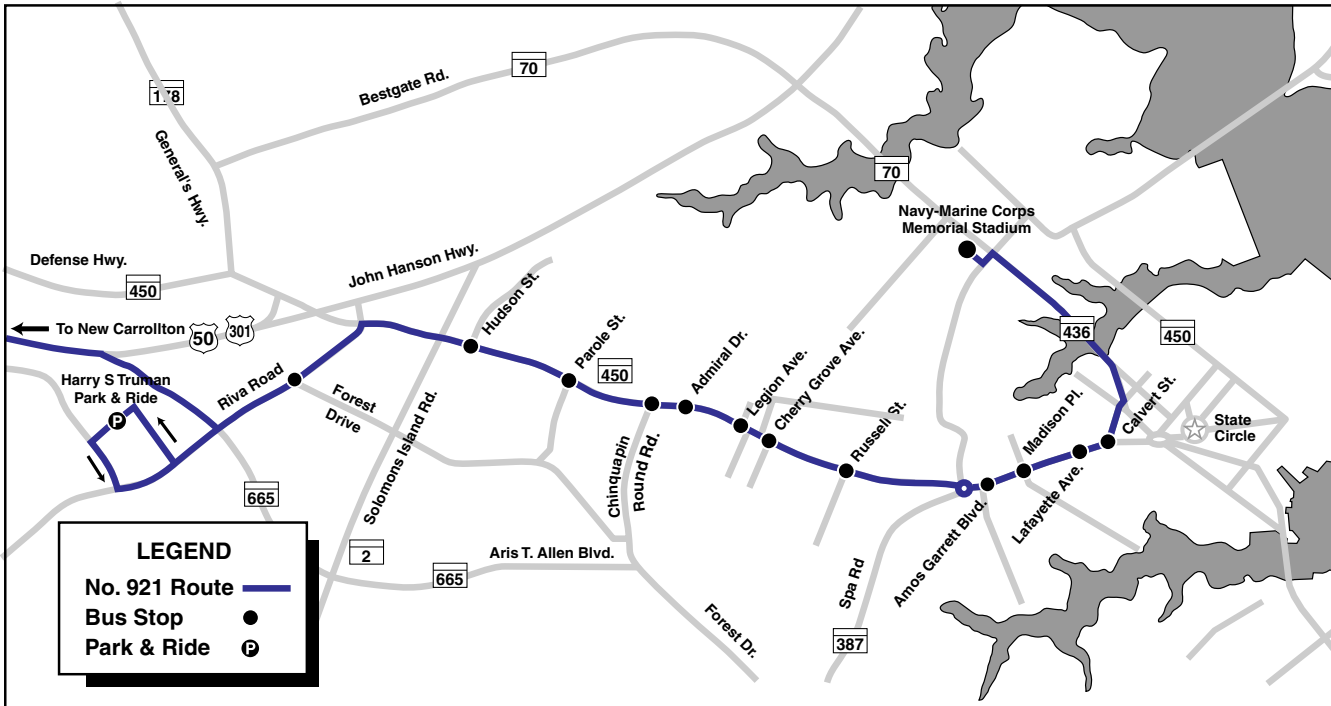
Only trips marked "H" above the Trip Number on the schedule will operate on the following federally-observed holidays:

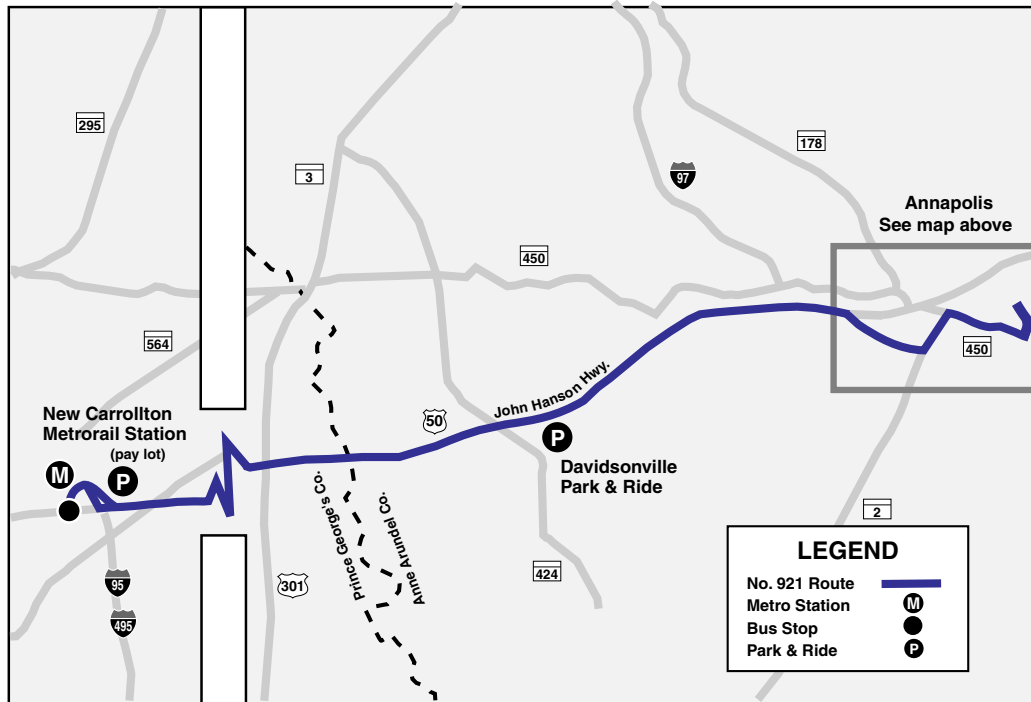
Using the Timetable

1. Select the correct section of the schedule for your direction of travel.

3. Continue reading down to find your destination stop.
4. Read across from your destination stop to the time you would like to arrive.
5. Read back up from your arrival time to the row across from your origin stop to find out what time to catch the bus.
